

## HARVARD REFERENCING GUIDELINES FOR MYP – Year 6

### Why do we reference?

Referencing is a way of giving credit to the people who have done the research. It is a way of showing that you have read and understood what you are writing about.

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### What parts of my work do I need to reference?

At Year 6, you need to reference **direct quotations**, which are words that you have copied exactly from a source.

When you use direct quotations, you must reference them. This means you must give the name of the person who said the words and the source where you found them.
